CONSENT TO PUBLISH/COPYRIGHT AGREEMENT

This Agreement dated _____ (date) is by and between the Journal of the Kentucky Academy of Science, the “Journal”, and _____, the “Author(s)”.
In consideration of the following mutual undertakings, it is agreed that

1. The Author(s) has created a Work entitled

_____ (the “Work”) and owns the copyright to the Work.

2. The Author(s) hereby transfers to the Journal the copyright to the Work and hereby grants to the Journal a worldwide, perpetual, irrevocable, fully-paid up, royalty-free license to publish the Work in paper form, electronic form, or any other format or medium at any time and in any context. The Journal also shall have the right to include the Work as part of its collection available on interlibrary loan.

3. The Author(s) warrants that the Work has not been published before nor presently submitted to another Journal in any form except as a preprint. The Author(s) further agree that s/he shall not publish the Work in any other Journal, paper, electronic or otherwise, in the same or substantially the same form as the Work without acknowledging prior publication in the Journal.

4. In the event of receiving any request to reprint or translate all of part of the Work, the Journal shall seek to inform the Author(s).

5. This Agreement shall become effective and binding at the date of formal acceptance of the Work for publication by the Journal.

6. By signing the Agreement, the Author(s) (and in the case of a Work Made for Hire, the Employer and Author(s)) warrant that the Work is original and does not infringe any existing copyrights. In the case of a Work Made for Hire, the signing employer also warrants that s/he has the power to enter into all provisions of the Agreement. In the case of multiple Authors, the signing Author warrants that s/he is authorized to sign the Agreement on behalf of all authors.
